This stone is traditionally found in Brazil in very close proximity to Amethyst. There are a few pockets of Dendrite Opal that contain Amethyst.

The Amethyst tends to appear more as a purplish blue in the rich translucent areas. It is famous for its fern like pattern often looking like trees in a grove around a frozen pond.

The beauty of this stone is that it is very hard for an Opal. The famous Australian Black Opals are very soft. This is one of the hardest Opals out there with a hardness of 7.

This black and white stone looks fabulous with many solid colors, not just black and white.
