Ammolite is the mineralized remains of an Ammonite fossil, the predecessor to the Nautilus. The outside of the Ammonite Fossil is what turns into this rare natural beauty of reds, blues, greens, purple, yellow, and orange.

Although fossilized Ammonites are found all over the world, supplies of the colorful iridescent gem quality Ammolite are found only in southern Alberta, Canada, and only about 5% of this material actually yields gemstone material.

The Blackfoot tribe of North America discovered the Ammonite. They believed it would ward off evil spirits. Others believe that Ammolite is thought to enhance life energy, to radiate strength, and to alter negative energy into positive energy.
