*Spectrolite, the most valued type of Labradorite, comes from Finland and Madagascar. The name is derived from Labrador which is the main and original source of the Canadian variety of this feldspar stone. Most of our Labradorite is found in a small mine in Madagasscar and is famous for its rich blue vein. Finland's Labradorite is very famous for its brilliant colors of reddish orange, greens, aqua blues, and yellows.*

*A type of translucent feldspar which displays strong iridescence when viewed from different angles is a rare find. These veins are much more unusual than one would think. Regular feldspar (Labradorite) is usually a flashy grey stone so when we locate the rare beauties that nature offers you can see why we are drawn to it. Folklore or legend has it that this stone is know to bring for each person's strengths, originality, aids sleep, and helps in relating to others.*
