Rainbow Cal-silica is a newly discovered volcanic stone from Chihuahua, Mexico. As far as we can tell this stone was discovered in the early 1990's. This stone is found in vertical veins where the minerals drop in between crevices as they form. The colored layers consist of microcrystalline calcite bonded with blue allophane. This is a favorite stone of the Native American Indians because of its brilliant color tones. Cornealian, natural coral, lapis, yellow jade, and malachite, are all beautiful stones that blend well with this rich southwestern look.
